- Use appropriate clamps, tension devices, and vibration dampers to protect the cable from mechanical stress and wind-induced vibrations.
- Maintain the minimum bending radius and avoid dragging the cable over obstructions during installation.
- Perform routine inspections to detect wear, rodent...
