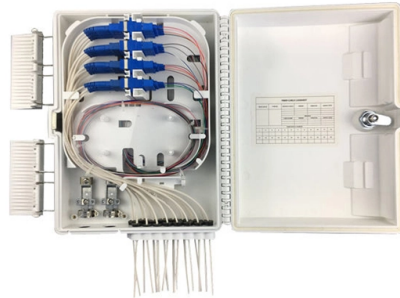

Safety In Fiber Optic Installations
