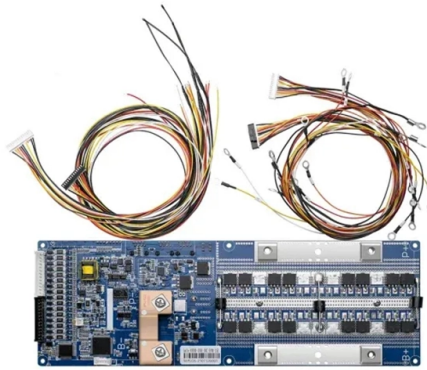


Burning the PoE Switch with Network Port
