Outdoor Butterfly Cables Outdoor variants, such as GJYXFCH or GJXFH, are designed for aerial or exposed installations (). They include: Steel messenger wires for self-supporting aerial spans up to 50 meters. Durable outer jackets resistant to UV, weather, and mechanical stress. Bend-insensitive fibers (G.657.A1 or A2) for routing through conduits or around corners. Suitable for connecting utility poles to buildings without additional support.

Flat Ribbon and Figure-8 Designs Butterfly cables often feature a flat, ribbon-like or figure-8 shape (): Figure-8 design: One loop contains the fiber, the other contains a steel or FRP reinforcement, ideal for aerial drops. Flat ribbon design: Flexible and easy to tuck along walls, under carpets, or around door frames, suitable for indoor or short outdoor runs.

Round or armored variants: Less common in butterfly form, used for underground or rodent-prone areas.

Fiber Counts and Materials Fiber counts: Typically 1-12 cores depending on residential or multi-dwelling applications. Strength members: FRP for non-metallic reinforcement or steel for self-supporting aerial cables. Sheath materials: LSZH for indoor safety, HDPE or flame-retardant PVC for outdoor durability.
