Supports must be spaced according to manufacturer recommendations and load calculations. Avoid cutting or drilling structural building members without approval. Tray Assembly: Connect straight lengths with splice plates and secure fittings. Ensure proper alignment and maintain minimum bend radii for cables exiting the tray. Cable Placement: Lay cables without exceeding tray load capacity. Maintain spacing to prevent overheating and allow for future cable additions. Safety Considerations: Cable ladders are not walkways or lifting devices. Installation should be performed by trained personnel following electrical safety cod...
