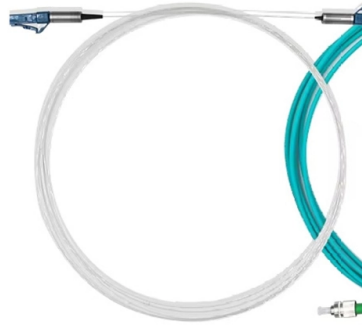


Cable laying construction on a six-meter-high cable tray
