Width: Cable tray widths typically range from 50 mm to 900 mm, depending on the number and size of cables to be accommodated. The width is measured as the nominal inside usable width, with the outside width slightly larger due to side rail thickness.

Depth (Side Rail Height): Standard depths range from 50 mm to 150 mm, controlling vertical stacking capacity and influencing heat dissipation and NEC fill compliance. Increasing width often provides better airflow and easier cable pulling than simply increasing depth.

Length: Most cable trays are manufactured in 3-meter (10-foot) sections, which balances ease of transport and installation. This length is standard across ladder, perforated, and channel trays.

Material Thickness: Thickness affects load capacity, allowable span, and long-term durability. Typical ranges vary by tray type, with ladder trays requiring thicker side rails for heavy cable loads and long spans.

Tray Type Considerations

Ladder Trays: Designed for heavy loads and maximum heat dissipation. Key dimensions include rung spacing (commonly 150–230 mm), side rail height, and material thickness. Wider trays are preferred for large power runs.

Perforated/Channel Trays: Provide continuous bottom support with ventilation openings. Depth and width are critical for cable support and airflow.

Wire Mesh Trays: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and suitable for light cabling. Dimensions are optimized for flexibility and ease of installation.
