

Cable tray installation at an Iraqi power plant



AI Overview

Cable tray installation in power plants requires careful planning, proper material selection, secure support, and adherence to project specifications to ensure safety, reliability, and long-term performance.

Planning and Preparation Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine the layout, length, and location of cable trays and ladders within electrical rooms, plant rooms, and service corridors. Inspect all materials upon delivery to ensure compliance with approved submittals, and remove any damaged or unsuitable items from the site. Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at one-meter intervals, protecting them from moisture and sunlight.

Material Selection Cable trays should be manufactured from hot-dip galvanized carbon steel or other corrosion-resistant materials suitable for the plant environment. Aluminum trays may be used for their corrosion resistance, while steel trays can be protected via galvanization. The choice of material depends on environmental conditions, load requirements, and project specifications. Covers should be provided in areas with high risk of mechanical damage.

Installation Procedure

Support and Fixing: Cable trays must be self-supporting and fixed to steel or concrete structures using standard steel shapes, welded supports, or self-drilling dowels. Maximum support spacing is typically 3 meters for ladder trays and 2 meters for perforated trays to prevent strain.

Orientation: Trays should be installed flat wherever possible, running under flooring or walkways. Vertical or edgewise installation is only used in special cases. Cables on vertical trays should be secured with stainless steel strips at two per meter, while horizontal trays use group fastening every 2-3 meters.

Load Capacity: Design trays to carry a load of 100 kg/m, ensuring structural integrity and safe cable management.
