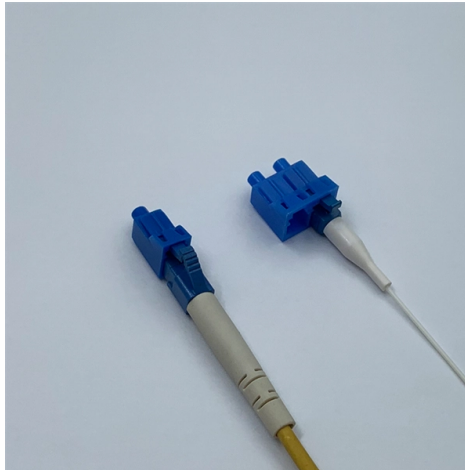


Cable tray left bend down bend

Vertical inside or outside bends allow the tray to drop while changing horizontal direction. These bends are typically made from galvanized or carbon steel and may include hardware for secure attachment. The bend radius should be chosen to prevent cable damage and maintain proper strain relief.

On-Site Fabrication Some modular systems, like EzyTray, allow installers to fabricate bends on-site. This involves bending the tray sidewalls down and using brackets (e.g., TX brackets) to secure the bend. Riser links are installed in pairs to maintain stability, and splice plates or bolts are used to join sections. This method provides flexibility for custom angles or when pre-fabricated bends are not available.

Installation Tips Ensure the bend radius is sufficient for the cable type to avoid kinking or excessive stress. Use rigidity clips or brackets to secure bends and maintain structural integrity. For vertical drops, always install riser links in pairs to prevent twisting. Consider material and finish (e.g., galvanized steel, powder-coated, or mesh) for corrosion resistance and compliance with standards. Pre-fabricated bends are faster and safer, especially in elevated installations, while on-s...
