- 3. Perforated Horizontal Elbows:** Some manufacturers provide powder-coated perforated steel elbows that allow airflow and cooling of cables, reducing overheating risks. These elbows can be installed without cutting or reconnecting the tray, offering flexibility and adaptability for different layouts (Youmats).
- 4. Vertical Angle Adjustments:** For vertical orientation changes, elbow joints can be pushed inside the tray and attached with screws, allowing adjustments from -90° to +90° (Meka).

Calculations for Fabrication To make precise bends, formulas can be used to determine the size of cut-out sections. For example, a 600mm wide tray can be divided into two 45° cuts or multiple smaller angles to achieve a smooth 90° bend. The cut-out size is calculated by dividing the tray width by the number of angle segments (MathIsFunForum).

Installation Tips Ensure accurate measurement and marking before cutting. Use proper cutting tools such as angle grinders or hacksaws. Drill and bolt the joints securely; use connecting plates for larger trays. Apply rust protection to exposed metal. For pre-fa...
