Specialized Support Fittings Specialized support fittings include center suspensions, T-pieces, crossovers, and end closures. These elements allow for changes in routing direction, height, or width of cable trays. Mounting elements like plates or clips are used to attach junction boxes or devices to the tray system, enhancing flexibility and safety.
