

Can a switch use a single fiber optic cable

Summary In standard configurations, two strands of fiber are required to connect switches using SFP modules. A single fiber strand can only be used if both ends employ BiDi SFP transceivers, which are designed for single-fiber bidirectional communication. For most conventional setups, duplex fiber remains the recommended and widely supported approach.
