

# Can two layers of vertical cable trays be installed

Threaded rods with cross members and washers are commonly used to secure the trays, allowing for minor horizontal adjustments during installation.

**Fittings and Alignment** Fittings such as vertical bends, T-pieces, and crossovers are used to change direction or layer trays without compromising cable integrity. Tray clips can be installed inside or outside the tray, depending on space and interference with rungs or connectors. It is essential to ensure that the trays are level and aligned to prevent sagging or uneven load distribution.

**Cable Management and Safety** Maintain minimum bend radii for cables as they enter or exit the trays to avoid damage. Rung spacing of 150–230 mm is recommended for instrumentation and control cables to provide adequate support. Double-layer installations should also consider heat dissipation, especially if power...
