Construction began in February 2022. The expected cable length is. China Telecom and TransTeleCom (TTK) have completed one of the world's first terrestrial high-bit-rate fiber routes connecting China and Europe. The 100G cable connects data points across Asia to Frankfurt, Germany, with interconnected communications lines at Russian Zabaikalsk and Chinese. Fibre-optic Link Around the Globe (FLAG) is a 28,000-kilometre-long (17,398 mi; 15,119 nmi) fibre optic mostly-submarine communications cable that connects the United Kingdom, Japan, India, and many places in between.
