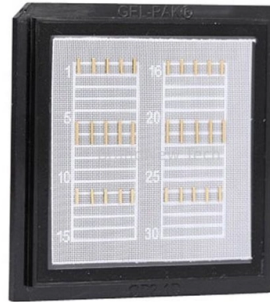

Conduit Selection and Installation

PVC or GI conduits are commonly used for concealed wiring, providing protection against mechanical damage and rodents. Conduits should be 2 mm thick and 25 mm in diameter for typical domestic installations. Dry rooms allow installation of conductors directly in conduits, while sheathed cables can be used in areas with minimal water exposure (IP x1 or higher). Conduits must be laid straight, without unnecessary bends, and securely fixed to prevent movement during plastering or wall finishing. Color coding is recommended: grey for data cables, black for electrical wires, and proper solvent for joining accessories.

Step-by-Step Installation Procedure

Slab Conduits: Lay conduits in the slab between top and bottom reinforcement, using deep junction boxes and binding wires to secure them.

Wall Conduits: After brickwork curing, chase walls and install conduits vertically and horizontally to switch boxes and distribution boxes, maintaining straight runs and avoiding clustering.

Switch and Back Boxes: Install switch boxes and back boxes at planned locations, ensuring alignment with c...
