- Foundation:** Excavate a minimum of 60 cm and compact the soil to provide a stable base for the concrete frame (PROCEED standards).
- Reinforcement:** Use steel reinforcement in slabs and walls according to calculated bending moments and shear forces.
- Slab and wall thickness:** Determined based on load analysis; top slab may be thicker if surface loads are significant.
- Pipe integration:** In water distribution boxes, inlet, outlet, and overflow pipes are arranged before pouring concrete to ensure proper alignment and sealing.

.Installation and Safety For electrical distribution boxes, the concrete frame serves as a protective enclosure. Proper placement ensures accessibility, ventilation, and compliance with IP/NEMA ratings. The frame must be level and stable to prevent tilting or structural stress on internal components.
