Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to verify settings and enable features like Quality of Service (QoS) if needed. Check the router's indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Verify the Internet Connection Test connectivity on a device connected to the router. If the connection fails, ensure all cables are properly seated, the ONT is powered, and the router settings match your ISP's requirements. Safety and Handling Tips Avoid bending fiber optic cables sharply to prevent damage. Handle fiber connectors by the plastic housing and keep protective caps on until ready to connect. Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power out...
