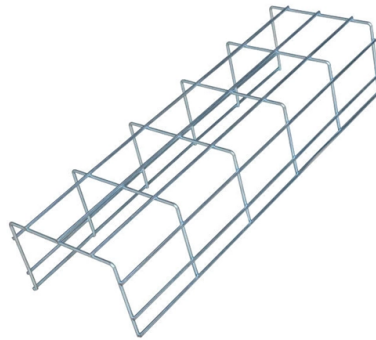


Connecting the explosion-proof distribution box to power
