

Construction steps for fireproof cable trays

Gaps between cables and trays should be filled with fireproof mortar or intumescent materials, applied evenly to create a compact barrier. Ensure protective steel plates are securely fixed and coated with fireproof paint to maintain integrity.

Ventilation and Heat Management Proper airflow is critical to prevent overheating, which can compromise fire resistance. Use perforated or wire mesh trays and maintain adequate spacing between cables to allow heat dissipation. Avoid overloading trays and ensure cables are organized with separators, covers, and clamps to reduce fire risk.

Installation Best Practices Reserve openings slightly larger than the tray dimensions to allow effective sealing. Layer fire blocking materials carefully, aligning with water stop platforms in vertical shafts. Ensure tray connections are firm, straight, and properly grounded. Avoid modifying or damaging tray coatings during installation.
