

Converting fiber optic internet to wireless router

Fiber optic internet delivers data using light signals through glass or plastic fibers, offering high-speed, low-latency connections. Unlike traditional cable or DSL, fiber requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the fiber signal into an Ethernet signal that your router can use. You cannot connect a fiber cable directly to a standard wireless router; the ONT is essential for signal conversion.

Equipment Needed

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT)** – Installed by your ISP to convert fiber signals to Ethernet.
- Wireless Router** – Distributes the internet to your devices. Ensure it has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to handle fiber speeds.
- Ethernet Cable (CAT5e or CAT6 recommended)** – Connects the ONT to the router.
- Power Supply** – Powers both the ONT and the router.

Step-by-Step Setup

- Locate and Power the ONT** – Usually installed on an exterior wall or in a basement. Ensure it is powered on and active.
- Connect the Router to the ONT** – Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet output to the router's WAN port.
- Power Up the Router** – Turn on the router and wait for the lights to stabilize.
- Configure Router Settings** – Access the router's admin panel to set up Wi-Fi SSID, password, and any ISP-specific settings such as VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE if required.
- Test Connectivity** – Verify internet access on multiple devices and check speeds to ensure optimal performance.

Router Compatibility and Performance

Routers designed for DSL or cable (coaxial input) will not work with fiber. For full fiber speeds, use a modern router with Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 and a Gigabit WAN port. Using your own router allows more control over network settings, security, and performance, but you are responsible for troubleshooting.
