Fiber Optic QSFP Cables (AOC)

Active Optical Cables (AOC) convert electrical signals to optical signals for transmission over fiber. Key features include:

- Longer distances:** Short-distance AOCs can reach beyond 7 meters, while single-mode fiber can extend up to 10 km or more.
- Higher power consumption:** Typically 3.5–4.5 watts per connection due to integrated laser diodes.
- Electromagnetic immunity:** Fiber is not affected by EMI and can navigate complex routing paths.
- Use cases:** Rack-to-rack or data center interconnects where longer distances or flexible routing are required.

Breakout Cables

QSFP breakout cables split a single high-speed QSFP port into multiple lower-speed SFP+ connections:

- Copper breakout:** Limited to 5 meters.
- Fiber breakout:** Can reach up to 150 meters, providing flexibility for network upgrades.
