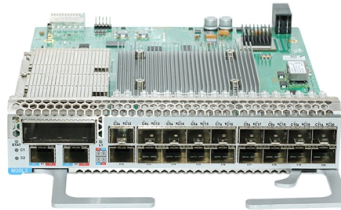

In order to set up a cluster, an active link between the primary and the secondary node must exist (as shown above in Figure 3). This is called a “cluster link” and can comprise one or more ports directly
