Importance of Core Switch Backups

- Disaster Recovery:** Quickly restore configurations to new hardware if a switch fails.
- Mitigating Human Error:** Revert incorrect commands or configuration changes immediately.
- Audit and Compliance:** Maintain historical records for security audits and configuration tracking.
- Maintenance Safety:** Ensure recovery before firmware upgrades or IOS updates.

Backup Methods

- Using FTP Server**
 - Configure an FTP server accessible from the switch.
 - Set IP addresses on both the switch and FTP server.
 - Add FTP credentials on the switch (ip ftp username / ip ftp password).
 - Use commands like `copy running-config ftp:` to transfer the active configuration to the server.
 - This method is preferred for routine enterprise backups and allows centralized storage.
- Using PuTTY Terminal**
 - Open PuTTY and connect to the switch via SSH or console.
 - Run `show running-config` to display the current configuration.
 - Save the output to a local file (log file) for backup.
 - This method is simple and useful for ad-hoc backups or smaller networks.
- Redundancy and High Availability Considerations**
 - In high-availability setups, use identical core switch models with the same IOS and features to ensure seamless failover.
 - Implement logical redundancy protocols like VRRP or HSRP to allow a secondary switch to take over instantly if the primary fails.
 - Maintain synchronized backups on both primary and secondary switches to minimize downtime.

- Backup Running Configurations:** Always back up the running configuration as it reflects the current operational state.
- Secure Storage:** Store backups securely,...
