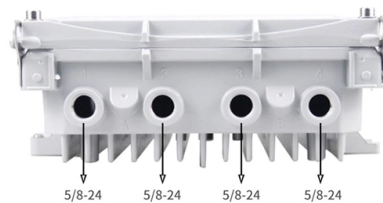


Cost of laying underground fiber optic cables
