Rack DepthRack depth is critical for fitting modern servers, storage arrays, and GPU systems. Standard depths range from 24 inches (~600 mm) to 48 inches (~1200 mm). Typical recommendations include:

- 600-800 mm – sufficient for switches, patch panels, and shallow equipment
- 1000-1200 mm – preferred for deep servers, high-performance storage, or GPU systems

Deeper racks allow for better airflow, rear cable clearance, and accommodate vertical PDUs.

- Open-frame racks – cost-effective, provide easy access and unobstructed airflow, ideal for cooling-intensive environments
- Enclosed racks (cabinets) – offer security, dust protection, and controlled airflow, suitable for high-density or sensitive equipment
