Connect end-use equipment directly to the secondary distribution board instead of using tertiary boxes. Ensure that each device has its own dedicated circuit breaker or RCD to maintain safety .

Implement Two-Level Protection

Use main and secondary boards only, with RCDs and circuit breakers at the secondary level to provide both area-lev...
