- Busbars:** The live and neutral conductors are connected to phase and neutral busbars, which distribute power to individual circuit breakers. The earth wire is connected to an earth bar.
- Outgoing Circuit Breakers (MCBs/RCBOs):** Each outgoing circuit is connected to a miniature circuit breaker (MCB) or RCBO, which protects the circuit from overloads and short circuits.
- Output to Loads:** From the MCBs or RCBOs, power is delivered to the respective circuits, such as lighting, sockets, or appliances.

- Main Switch/Isolator:** Provides full isolation and overcurrent protection for the entire installation.
- MCBs:** Protect individual circuits from overload and short-circuit currents.
- RCCBs/RCDs:** Detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks.
- RCBOs:** Combine MCB and RCD functions for individual circuits, improving fault selectivity.
- Busbars:** Conduct and distribute electricity efficiently to multiple circuits.
- Earth Bar:** Ensures proper grounding for safety.
