- Safety:** Avoid installing near wet areas, corrosive gases, heat sources, or locations prone to impact or vibration.
- Special groups:** Adjust height for children, elderly, or individuals with disabilities to ensure safe and convenient access.
- Standards compliance:** Follow local electrical codes such as IEC, NEC, or BS standards to ensure proper installation, grounding, and protection devices.
