Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be $< 1 \Omega$. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Distribution System Grounding

Good system grounding provides the path for normal load and fault currents while maintaining load and controls temporary overvoltages. Good equipment grounding ensures

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

How To Ground The Distribution Box

The metal box itself should be processed with a "box grounding bolt" (with PE mark), which must be connected to the grounded PE bus with a copper core wire or a special braided soft wire;

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
