Correct breaker wiring: 1P (single-pole) breakers: Connect the live (L) wire to the breaker terminal; the neutral (N) wire goes directly to the neutral busbar. 2P (double-pole) breakers: Both live and neutral wires are connected to the breaker terminals, ensuring simultaneous disconnection during a trip. Protective earth (PE): Always connect the PE wire to the ground busbar to prevent electric shock and ensure RCD protection if installed. Step-by-Step Example Turn off the main power supply. Mount the breakers in the distribution box. Connect the incoming live wire to the busbar or breaker terminals. Connect each branch circuit directly to the busbar or breaker terminal. Connect neutral wires to the neutral busbar and earth wires to the ground busbar. Double-check all connections for tightness and correct polarity before restoring power.
