A standard connection box or Ethernet cable does not automatically include both ends pre-terminated; each end must be properly connected according to wiring standards. Ethernet Cable Termination For Ethernet cables, the pin configuration must be consistent on both ends to ensure proper communication between devices. Standard cables (straight-through) use the same wiring standard, either T568A or T568B, on both ends, while crossover cables intentionally use different standards on each end to connect similar devices directly, such as two computers or two switches. Each end of the cable must be terminated with an 8P8C (commonly called RJ45) connector, following the correct pinout sequence. The box itself does not include both ends of the cable pre-connected; it serves as a structured point for wiring and ensures proper alignment of the twisted pairs to minimize crosstalk and interference. Electrical Wiring Analogy In general electrical wiring, a connection box (junction box) allows multiple wires to be joined safely. While it may contain terminals for connecting wires, each wire must be brought into the box and connected individually. The box does not provide pre-connected wires to both ends of a circuit; it is a central point for making secure connections.
