

Electrical Distribution Box Wiring Specifications

Cable Management: Arrange wires neatly, avoid exposed copper, and label all circuits for easy identification.

Insulation: Ensure proper insulation and use insulating tape or ties as needed.

Protective Devices

Circuit Breakers and Fuses: Each circuit should have its own breaker or fuse rated according to the load.

RCCB/Residual Current Devices: Provide protection against leakage currents and electric shocks, with ratings matching the main MCB.

Surge Protectors: Optional but recommended for sensitive equipment.

Grounding: The metal box, internal boards, and appliances must be reliably grounded with adequate cross-sectional area, connected to the grounding network.

Compliance with Standards Follow IEC 60364, BS 7671, or NEC depending on location. Ensure UL, CE, or CCC-certified components are used. Maintain adequate c...
