When these quantities exceed preset thresholds, the relay closes its contacts, completing the trip circuit of a circuit breaker, which then disconnects the faulty section. The relay's operation depends on parameters like pickup settings, time delays, and coordination with upstream and downstream devices to ensure selective isolation of faults.

Types of Protective Relays Protective relays can be classified based on operating principle, construction, or function:

- Electromechanical Relays:** Use moving parts and electromagnetic forces; traditional and reliable but limited in functionality.
- Static Relays:** Use electronic components without moving parts, offering faster response.
- Numerical (Digital) Relays:** Microprocessor-based relays that combine multiple protection functions, provide event recording, self-diagnostics, and communication capabilities.

Based on function, relays include:

- Overcurrent Relay:** Trips when current exceeds a preset limit.
- Differential Relay:** Detects differences in current between two points, commonly used for transformers and generators.
- Distance Relay:** Operates based on impedance, used in transmission line protection.
- Earth Fault Relay:** Detects leakage currents to ground.
- Over/Under Voltage and Frequency Relays:** Protect against...
