Adjustable Brackets and Pedestals When installing waterproof or outdoor distribution boxes, adjustable mounting brackets or pedestal systems are often used to achieve the correct elevation. These brackets allow micro-adjustments during installation to compensate for uneven surfaces, masonry inconsistencies, or site-specific drainage requirements. Adjustable brackets also help maintain ergonomic access for maintenance personnel and ensure compliance with accessibility regulations, typically keeping the box between 0.4 meters and 2.0 meters from the floor depending on the environment. Environmental and Safety Considerations Flood protection: Outdoor boxes should be mounted above the highest recorded water line, usually at least 300 mm above flood levels, to prevent water ingress. Cable management: Proper height ensures correct cable tension and allows for a "drip loop" to prevent moisture from entering the enclosure. Mechanical stress: Avoid mounting too high, which can increase wind load, or too low, which risks accidental impact. Reinforced struts or brackets can provide structural support while allowing incremental height adjustments. Accessibility: Ensure the box is reachable for reading labels, performing maintenance, and operating switches without strain
