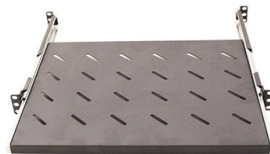


Error Standards for Optical Cable Segments

Overview

The International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and the Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA) create detailed rules for fiber optic components, manufacturing, and testing. The fiber optic link attenuation is tested using an optical loss test set (OLTS) or a light source and power meter (LSPM) Figure 1).
