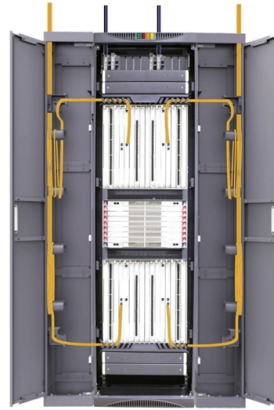


Fiber Optic Cable Color Strip Diagram

For example, Fiber #34 in a 48-fiber cable would be the Violet fiber in the Green tube (third tube, tenth fiber). Cable Jacket Colors Cable jackets are also color-coded to indicate fiber type and application: Singlemode (OS1/OS2): Yellow Multimode 50/125 OM3/OM4: Aqua Multimode 62.5/125 OM1: Orange Indoor/Plenum-rated cables: Typically off-white or beige Outdoor/Direct-burial cables: Black or other UV-resistant colors These jacket colors help technicians quickly identify fiber types and prevent mismatched connections. Connector and Strain Relief Colors Fiber connectors and strain relief boots often match the fiber type for easy identification: Singlemode connectors: Blue Multimode OM1/OM2: Beige Multimode OM3/OM4: Aqua APC (Angled Physical Contact) connectors: Green This ensures consistent identification across the connection interface. High-Count Fiber Identification For cables with more than 12 fibers, extended color coding is used: 16-fiber MPO connectors: Fibers 13-16 are Olive, Magenta, Tan, and Lime Ribbon cables: Stripes or printed legends may be used to identify fibers beyond 144 strands Custom jacket colors: Some manufacturers provide RAL-coded jackets or printed legends for large-scale deployments.
