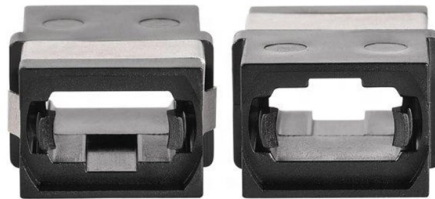

- Aerial Installation:** Mount fiber on utility poles using proper tensioning to avoid sagging or damage.
- Indoor Routing:** Run cables through walls, ceilings, or conduits, respecting bending-radius and tensile limits to prevent signal loss.

Splicing and Termination Fiber optic cables are joined using fusion splicing or mechanical splicing. Fusion splicing provides low-loss connections (0.02–0.1 dB typical) and is preferred for single-mode fibers. Ensure clean cleaves and proper alignment of fiber cores. Terminate cables with connectors and organize them in patch panels for easy access and maintenance.

Testing and Verification After installation, test the network using an OTDR to locate faults and measure signal loss, and a power meter/light source to verify optical power levels. Use a visual fault locator for quick continuity checks. Document all splices, t...
