

Fiber Optic Dual Router Setup

LAN-to-LAN method: Connect a LAN port on the primary router to a LAN port on the secondary router. Configure the secondary router in Access Point mode to extend the same network without creating a double NAT scenario. For wireless extension, some routers support wireless repeater mode, but wired connections are more stable and faster.

Step 4: Configure IP Addresses Assign a static IP address to the secondary router within the same subnet as the primary router but outside the DHCP range to prevent conflicts. For example, if the primary router is 192.168.1.1, set the secondary router to 192.168.1.2.

Step 5: Configure Wi-Fi Settings Set different SSIDs for each router if you want to identify them separately, or use the same SSID for seamless roaming. Use strong passwords and select Wi-Fi channels to minimize interference. Place the primary router centrally and the secondary router where the signal is strong but can reach dead zones.
