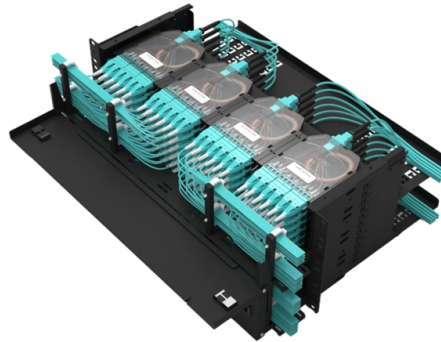

- Pulling and Blowing:** Cables can be pulled through conduits or blown into microducts using compressed air. Blowing is effective for high fiber count microcables and reduces friction during installation.
- Splicing and Termination:** Long-distance cables are spliced using fusion or mechanical splicing. Singlemode cables are usually not field-terminated due to the precision required for low-loss co...
