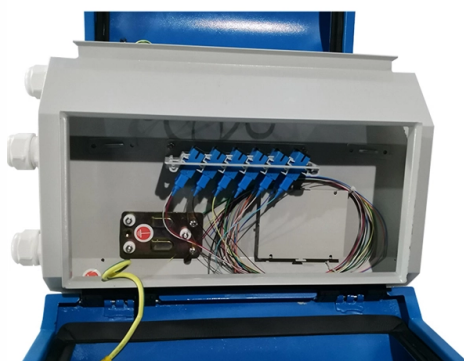


Fiber optic cable connector installation length

Proper fiber optic connector installation requires precise cable preparation, typically stripping 1.35 inches of the outer jacket and 0.75 inches of the fiber coating, with additional length for buffer and strength members to ensure low-loss connections.

Cable Preparation Lengths For most fiber optic connectors, the following lengths are recommended during installation:

- Outer Jacket Strip:** Remove approximately 1.35 inches (34 mm) of the cable jacket at the termination point to expose the buffer and strength members.

These lengths provide sufficient material for proper connector assembly, polishing, and testing while maintaining strain relief and minimizing the risk of fiber breakage.

Considerations for Long Cable Runs Ensure the total cable length is sufficient to reach the termination point without excessive tension or bending. For runs over 40 meters, use lubricants compatible with the cable jacket and consider the figure-8 technique to prevent twisting. Avoid pulling on the connector itself; use a pulling grip designed for pre-connected fiber cables to prevent damage. Maintain the minimum bend radius and avoid exceeding the maximum tensile load to prevent microbends or fiber breakage.

Connector Performance Properly prepared lengths ensure that the connector achieves low insertion loss, typically well under 0.5 dB, and meets the TIA/EIA-568B.3 standard maximum of 0.75 dB per connection. Incorrect lengths or improper stripping can introduce signal loss, misalignment, or damage to the fiber end-face.
