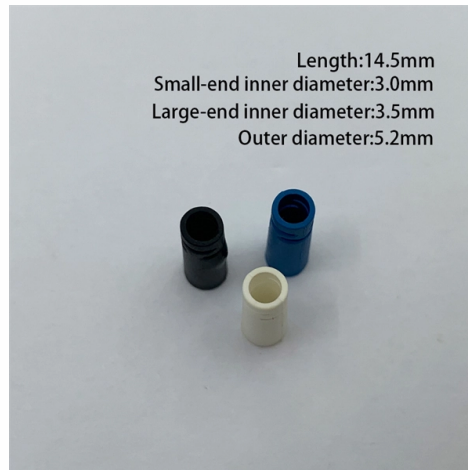

For in-field splicing, use fusion splicing to minimize signal loss.
