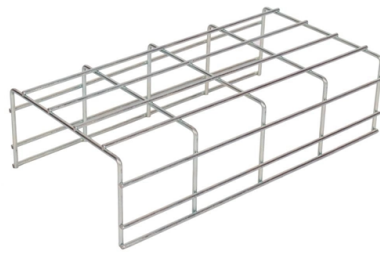


Fiber optic network main and secondary routers



AI Overview

For fiber optic internet, a high-performance main router paired with a secondary router or mesh system ensures maximum speed, coverage, and redundancy.

Main Router Selection The main router is the central hub connecting directly to your fiber modem or ONT (Optical Network Terminal). Key considerations include:

- Wi-Fi Standard:** Wi-Fi 6E or Wi-Fi 7 routers are recommended for multi-gig fiber plans, offering higher throughput, lower latency, and Multi-Link Operation (MLO) for simultaneous multi-band connections.
- Ethernet Ports:** Look for routers with 2.5G or 10G WAN/LAN ports to fully utilize fiber speeds and support LAN aggregation for faster wired connections.
- Coverage and Device Support:** High-end routers like the Netgear Nighthawk RS700S or ASUS ROG Rapture GT-AX11000 can cover large homes (up to 3,500 sq ft) and handle 200+ devices simultaneously.
- Security Features:** Built-in security like AiProtection or NETGEAR Armor helps protect all connected devices without additional subscriptions.

Secondary Router or Mesh System A secondary router can serve as a backup or extend coverage:

- Mesh Systems:** Devices like Google Nest WiFi Pro 6E or Linksys Velop AX4200 integrate seamlessly with the main router to eliminate dead zones and provide consistent speeds across multiple floors.
- Redundancy:** A secondary router can be configured in bridge mode or as a failover to maintain connectivity if the main router fails.

Placement: Position secondary units strategically to cover areas with weak signals, ensuring uninterrupted high-speed access.

Configuration Tips

- IP Management:** Assign static IPs or use DHCP reservation to avoid conflicts between main and secondary routers.
- Backhaul Options:** For mesh setups, use wired backhaul when possible to maximize speed and reduce latency.
- Firmware Updates:** Keep both routers updated...
