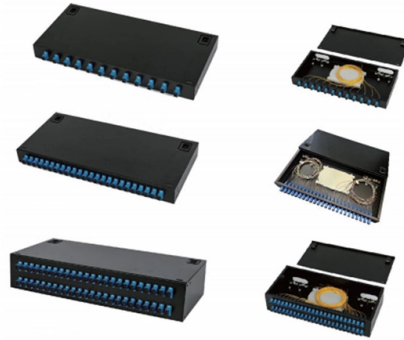


Fiber optic patch cord pulling

Modern bend-insensitive fibers can tolerate tighter bends, but older fibers require larger radii, often 30mm or more . Twisting, stretching, or pinching the cord can compromise the fiber inside, so avoid tight bundling or excessive tension . Connector Care The connectors at each end of a patch cord are critical for signal integrity. Never pull the cord by the connector, as this can misalign the fiber endface and increase insertion loss . Always ensure connectors are clean and free of dust or debris before and after handling, using lint-free wipes or dedicated fiber cleaning kits . Best Practices for Re-Routing Use proper cable management: Route cords through vertical or horizontal channels to prevent strain . Check cord length: Ensure the patch cord is long enough to reach without stretching . Inspect before use: Look for physical damage, kinks, or bent connectors . Avoid force: If a cord cannot be moved easily, identify and resolve the obstruction rather than pulling harder . Following these practices ensures long-term reliability, low insertion loss, and safe handling of fiber optic patch cords in data centers, FTTH deployments, and enterprise networks .
