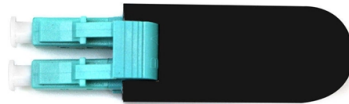

- Factory-grade connector quality for low insertion loss and high return loss
- Flexibility to splice into any fiber cable system
- Time and labor savings compared to field-terminated connectors

For dual-fiber transceivers, two pigtails are used—one for the transmit fiber and one for the receive fiber—ensuring a clean, low-loss connection between the transceiver and the network fiber infrastructure.

Connector Types and Fiber Modes

When selecting pigtails for dual-fiber transceivers, consider:

- Connector type:** LC, SC, ST, or FC, matching the transceiver interface
- Fiber mode:** Single-mode (OS2) for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications, or multimode (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances
- Polish type:** UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) for optimal signal performance

Practical Setup

Splice the bare ends of the pigtails to the incoming fiber cable using a fusion splicer or mechanical splice. Connect the factory-terminated ends to the dual-fiber transceiver's duplex LC ports. Secure the fibers in a splice tray or terminal box to prevent stress and maintain signal integrity...
