Unlike metal trays, fiberglass trays do not require painting or galvanizing, and they maintain their integrity in humid or corrosive environments. The surface treatment also ensures compliance with ASTM E-84 Class 1 flame rating and ASTM D-635 self-extinguishing standards. Quality Control Quality inspection is critical.
