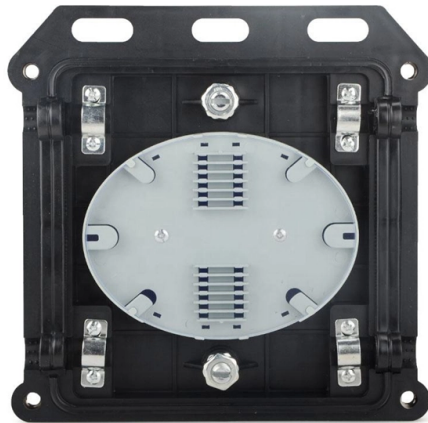


Fire resistance rating requirements for fire-fighting cable trays



Overview

UL 1257 is a widely recognized testing standard that evaluates fire-resistant cable tray and conduit assemblies. It ensures these components meet specific performance criteria under extreme temperature conditions. - How often should I conduct UL 1257 testing on my equipment?

Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with design requirements. Process flow: reserved openings → busway installation → distribution box positioning and installation →. EI60, EI90, and EI120 are widely used fire resistance targets in cable tray specifications, yet they are often applied without a clear link to project risk, tested configurations, and lifecycle implications.
