- Firestop Materials:** Use fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or mineral wool to seal gaps around trays.
- Installation Requirements:** Ensure gaps are tightly packed, with no visible cracks or voids. For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing.
- Penetration Systems:** Modular systems like SLIPSIL, RISE®, or FIRSTO provide fire-safe, gas- and watertight sealing for single or multiple cable penetrations. These systems expand or compress to maintain tight seals and can be installed quickly around existing cables.
- Gap and Thickness Standards:** The gap between firestop packs and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and packing thickness should meet design specifications,...
