

Fixing wires in cable trays

- Ceiling-Mounted Supports (Trapeze Hangers): Suspend trays from ceilings using rods and flat bars, keeping cables out of the way and accessible for maintenance ().
- Floor-Mounted Bases: Used in industrial settings where wall or ceiling mounting is impractical ().

Maintain proper support spacing between brackets or hangers, typically determined by tray type and cable weight, to prevent bending or sagging ().

- Avoid excessive bending; respect the minimum bend radius specified by the cable manufacturer ().
- Fix cables at regular intervals using cable ties, clamps, or straps to prevent movement and maintain spacing ().
- Use factory-made fittings like 90-degree bends, T-pieces, or crossovers to guide cables smoothly around corners or changes in elevation ().
- Label cables with markers for easy identification during maintenance ().
