Digicel's Undersea Cable Project Haiti is set to receive a 200 km undersea fiber optic cable, known as the FibrLink Extension, funded entirely by Digicel at a cost of US\$16 million. The strategy involves transferring majority ownership to a strategic investor to improve technical and financial capacities, modernize networks, and expand services. This includes the construction of a fiber optic cable network to provide internet access to remote towns and additional submarine cable access points, supporting long-term recovery and digital inclusion.

Fiber Optic Link via the Bahamas A separate initiative involves connecting Haiti digitally to the global network through the Bahamas, enabling direct, high-speed communication. This fiber optic link reduces reliance on satellite connections, improves call quality, increases internet bandwidth, and lowers operational costs for service providers, which can benefit consumers with faster and more reliable services.
