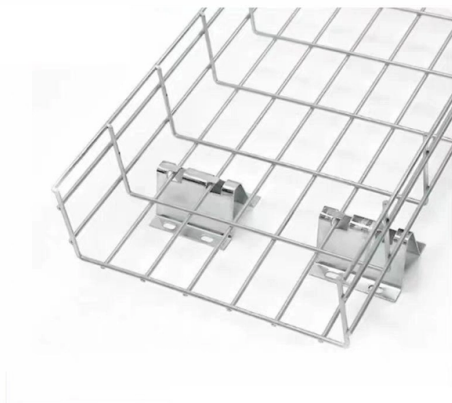


Home electrical panel trips overnight

- 5. Aging or Faulty Breakers** Sometimes the breaker itself is worn out or defective, causing it to trip even under normal loads. In such cases, replacement by a licensed electrician is necessary.

Troubleshooting Steps

Reset the breaker and unplug all devices on the affected circuit. Plug in devices one at a time to see if a specific appliance triggers the trip. Check for visible signs of damage, such as scorch marks, sparks, or burning smells. Avoid overloading circuits by redistributing high-wattage appliances across multiple circuits. Call a licensed electrician if trips persist, especially if the main breaker trips.
